Here's the important info you need for your stay

Children & Water Safety

The water is open and easily accessible. We *recommend* that all children who are not competent swimmers wear a life jacket whenever they are in the backyard. It takes only half a second for a child to fall off the sidewalk into the water. Please be careful!

Supplies & Furniture

The house is set up for you to use anything you find, including food in the pantry and fridge. There's a list of supplies inside the cabinet to the right of the refrigerator. **If you move something, we would appreciate your returning it to the location you found it.**

Fishing & Boating

Fishing equipment is located in the entry way. You are free to fish from the dock or along the peninsula. You are also welcome to use the canoe, kayaks or paddle boat. Under 18 are required by law to wear lifejackets in any boat. Over 18 must have a lifejacket with them.

Fire & Fireworks

BEFORE STARTING FIRE OUTSIDE OR USING FIREWORKS: Google "Henderson County" to find out if we are in a burn ban. If no burn ban, you are welcome to start a fire in the fire pit in the yard (firewood is located off the porch). Fireworks should be launched from the burn pile on the peninsula. Fireplace is always available.

PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE ANY OPENED OR PERISHABLE FOOD!!

Before You Leave

1

BEDS

If you used a bed, please leave it UNMADE. No need to take the sheets off.

2

TOWELS

Leave bathroom towels hanging in bathrooms and kitchen towels in the laundry room.

3

TRASH

Place all trash (bagged) in the green trash can at the end of the driveway.

4

DISHES

Feel free to leave the dishwasher running, but please do not leave dirty dishes in the sink.

FOOD

DO NOT leave any perishable food in the refrigerator or pantry (including open pkgs of chips/ crackers, etc.).

THERMOSTATS

Please set both A/Cs to 80° in summer or 65° in the winter. Turn off window units in Room 5 and 6.

7

OUTSIDE

Return all yard toys, fishing equipment, life jackets and outdoor furniture where it was when you arrived. Cover furniture on lower deck. Be sure both garage doors are closed and the back one is locked.

8

DOORS

Make sure all doors are closed, locked & bar is in the sliding door. As you leave, simply hit the lock button on the front door and make sure it is locked.
